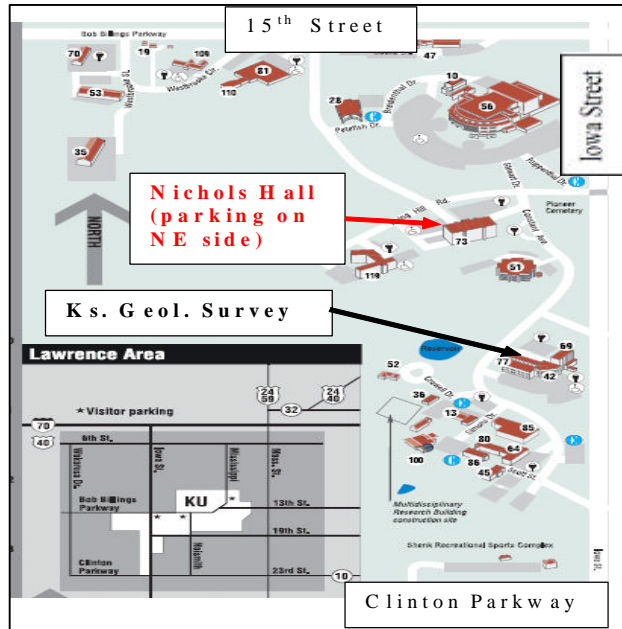
PfeFFER Pro (Petrofacies Evaluation of Formations for Engineering Reservoirs) is an Excel spreadsheet-based log analysis software. This one-day workshop will review all of the log analysis modules of PfeFFER introduced with theory followed by a systematic step-by-step access.
